

# Art

## Key Stage 2

### Term 1 and 2      Basic Skills

Primary emphasis will be focused on using painting media to explore the everyday aspects of 2-dimensional art, in particular `how to show realism`. In conjunction with this key art terminology will be used with the students encouraged to follow suit when they verbalise their experiences in art.

These basic skills will also be used to study the work of a chosen artist and that work copied and explored in further detail.

### Term 3 and 4      Three-dimensions (clay)

The students will explore the properties of shape, form, texture, pattern, space and line. Primarily with clay, though this could also other constructive media.

As a follow on, plaster would be used as a casting material to make a positive copy of a clay tile.

### Term 5 and 6      Art Appreciation (3-D)

In conjunction with the previous topic and a further extension the students will look a three-dimensional art, explore the processes used to create these differing works and experiment with the same or similar materials.

A visit to an art gallery will be an important part of this exercise.
