

PUPIL PREMIUM REPORT

At Ratcliffe School we use Pupil Premium to ensure:-

1. That teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all the pupils at our school.
2. That appropriate provision is made for children who belong to vulnerable groups.
3. That Pupil Premium will be allocated following analysis of needs which will identify those children who require extra support with basic skills in English and Maths as well as social skills development.

The range of provision will include:-

- Overcoming gaps in learning through individual support.
- Additional support through personalised timetables to build self-esteem and self-worth.
- Accelerated progress in reading and phonics.
- Funding for 1:1 support in Basic Skills to include phonics awareness.
- 1:1 pastoral support where needed.
- Financial support for additional resources in English and Maths.
- Targeted support.
- Enrich opportunities after school in order to develop self-esteem.

Our data shows that students make good progress here at Ratcliffe. We will continue to use the Pupil Premium Grant to enrich children's experiences to help them to become confident learners, both socially and academically.

MEASURING THE IMPACT OF PUPIL PREMIUM GRANT

Impact will be evaluated at the end of each academic year.

Focus will be on academic and social gains and how self-esteem and self-improvement have improved students' ability to learn.

However, it is important to realise that we must allow time for the strategies to have an impact, but it is important to monitor the impact on personal development and learning.
